# **Directions:** The picnic is located in Wolcott, north of Waterbury and Cheshire off of RT 84, or south of Bristol, off of RT 69.

**Coming from North on RT 69** – Make a left onto Woodtick Road and drive approx. 3.8 miles (cross Rte 322 but do not take it), then take a left onto Todd Road (intersection with Nichols Road). 1.2 miles down Todd Road, take a left onto Central Avenue. We are on the RIGHT side of the road (0.3 miles from the turn). The house is down the driveway and should be signed.

**Coming from RT 84 – take exit 28/ RT 322**. (both East and West, same directions) – Make a left onto RT 322 (Meriden Waterbury Turnpike) and drive approx. 1.7 mile. Stay straight and go to Meriden Road (DO NOT take a right onto RT 322) for another 0.9 miles. Turn right onto Todd Road and follow Todd Road for 0.7 miles. Take a RIGHT onto Central Avenue. We are on the RIGHT side of the road (0.3 miles from the turn). The house is down the driveway and should be signed.

**Coming from East on RT 691.** (Middletown and Meriden area) – Take RT 691 towards Waterbury. Take Exit 3 towards Milldale/Cheshire. Turn Right at the end of the ramp onto RT 10. Keep right at the fork to continue on RT 10. Take the first left onto RT 322 (Meriden Waterbury Turnpike) and drive approx. 3.1 mile. Stay straight and go to Meriden Road (DO NOT take a right onto RT 322) for another 0.9 miles. Turn right onto Todd Road and follow Todd Road for 0.7 miles. Take a RIGHT onto Central Avenue. We are on the RIGHT side of the road (0.3 miles from the turn). The house is down the driveway and should be signed.
