Coming from North on RT 8 – **take exit 39**/ **Bristol RT 6**. Make a left onto RT 6 and drive appox. 1 mile, near top of hill take a right onto Carter Road. This is actually Plymouth and turns into Thomaston at about 2.0 miles. We are on the right side of the road (2.7 miles from the turn) – a red farm house.


Race for the Woods:
