Club resumes in-person meetings

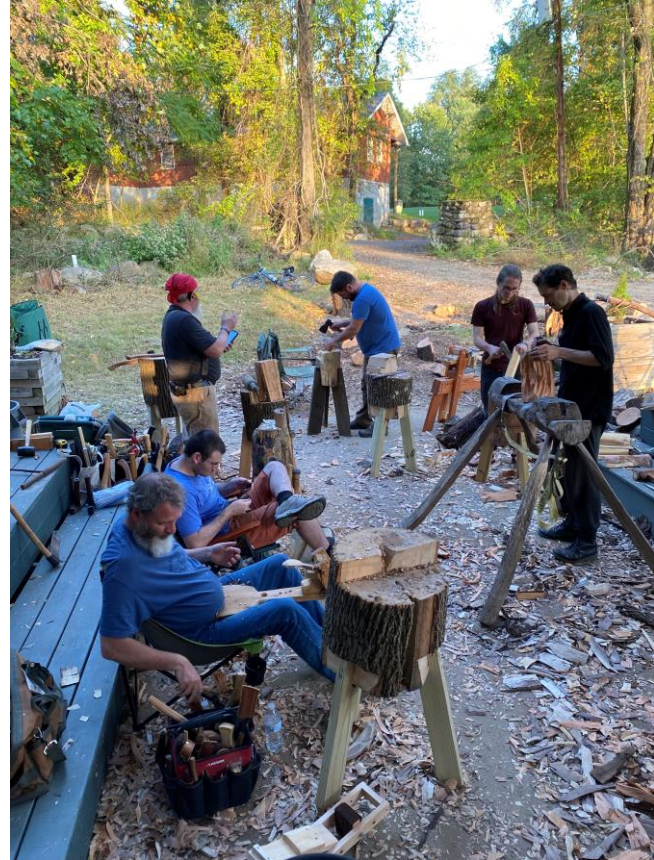
